This development involved the construction of a new warehouse and two story offices in Aston Birmingham. The site was the former HP sauce factory and featured numerous underground basements and various plateaus. The ground was poor and the foundations were vibro compacted.

A major drainage run across the site had to be diverted during the project.

The steel faceted portal frame roof was approximately 42m span.
