
King Edwards Wharf - Sheepcote Street Birmingham



Project Description

This project involved the development of 220 luxury apartments and associated facilities over 10 storeys on the corner of the canal loop in Birmingham. The scheme included restoration of a former industrial site and Grade II listed buildings.

The building has a precast concrete wall frame, along with hollowcore floors on a single storey RC frame, over car park level, with piled foundations.

The structure is part-steel framed in conjunction with precast wall frame and has cantilevered balconies.
