
Shirley Town Centre Re-development

Project Description

This mixed use development will redevelop the existing town centre of Shirley.

This will be done by the construction of 20 new retail units on two levels. A new 40,000 sq ft Asda superstore, cafes and restaurants. A 500 space basement car park will be built to accommodate those driving to the new shopping centre.

Alongside the retail & leisure developments will be the construction of 205 new residential apartments. Surface level car parking will be provided for residents of these apartments.

The development uses 1.43 acres of Shirley Park and as part of this project the existing park area will be enhanced. The construction of this project commenced May 2012.
