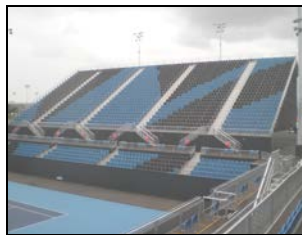


Eton Manor

Olympic Park, London



Project Description

This development involved the construction of temporary demountable seating grandstand structures for the wheelchair tennis event at the London 2012 Paralympic Games, based within the Eton Manor site at the London Olympic Park. Nolan Associates were involved in the full structural design and checking of 9 main court grandstands up to a maximum of 14m tall, a steel framed structure for media facilities and 4 small practice court stands. The stands were constructed from steel tubular hollow sections and aluminium extrusions based on GL Events Slick Seating standard tiered seating system. The venue in total provided seating for 10,500 spectators.
